- 1** Insert a single sheet of media into your printer. For straight path printers, the printable side will face up, for "U" path printers, the printable side will face down. Ensure only one sheet is loaded at a time to prevent the risk of jamming.
- 2** Open your printer driver settings by selecting **FILE**; then **PRINT**; and then **PROPERTIES**. Select a paper type such as "Glossy Photo Film" or "Ultra Premium Glossy Photo Paper" and then print your image(s).
- 3** After printing, allow the media to dry for approximately 15 minutes. To prepare the printed image for outdoor use, flush the sheet with generous amounts of water. By running the printed image under water, you remove excess inks that may run off your image and prevent the bleeding of colors. While flushing the image, if you notice there is excessive ink run off, adjust your printer settings and select a different paper type, such as "Transparency". If the sheet has a faded look, try using the "Plain Paper" setting.
- 4** After flushing, cut your decal(s) from the sheet with sharp scissors or an Exacto knife. The closer you cut to the image, the less excess material will appear on your target. After cutting the image(s) out, peel the liner from the back and apply, sticky side down, to your target. For best adhesion, it is important that the target surface be clean and that the image, after being applied, be afforded 24 hours for the adhesive to fully cure and set.



**BONUS TIPS!**

**To increase outdoor life expectancy, try using an Over-Laminate, available as a cold laminate sheet, or aerosol spray**

**Non-OEM inks (refill inks) are not recommended**

**Avoid "High Resolution" print settings**
